Dinghy Park Policy

- 1 DINGHIES shall be termed as small open boats or inflatable rubber boats.
- 2 DINGHIES including all trailers and supports shall be **NO LONGER THAN 16 FEET (4.88 metres)** with a maximum beam of **6 FEET (1.82 metres)**. Overall height of boat and trailer, excluding mast, to be no more than **6 FEET (1.82 metres)**.
- 3 DINGHIES shall be kept in a seaworthy condition. All trailers shall be kept in good condition and be fully mobile. Any trailers not fully mobile will be removed and disposed of. Small craft racks and stacking systems are to have a maximum height of **4 FEET (1.2 metres)** and the design and construction of such systems are to be approved by the Harbour Master.
- 4 DINGHIES will be allocated spaces by the Harbour Master as best suited to their lengths and availability.
- 5 DINGHIES shall be identified by displaying both the Harbour Authority annual licence sticker and have a name on the outboard face of the transom.
- 6 DINGHY spaces are not transferable nor able to be sub-let.
- 7 Owners must keep the Harbour Master informed in writing of any changes either to the address or boat details.
- 8 The Yarmouth Harbour Commissioners accept no responsibility for any damage or theft to property on the Dinghy Park.
- 9 DINGHIES found not in the allocated space will be removed to the Yarmouth Harbour Commissioners compound and a fee of £50 will be charged for their recovery.
- 10 No vehicles are allowed on the Dinghy Park area.
- 11 Licences to run from 1st January – 31st December with payment due 1st January.
- 12 Any outstanding funds due will be recovered from the sale of the dinghy after having taken full steps to contact the owner and in compliance with the Commissioners Terms and Conditions relating to Dinghy Park Licences.
- 13 The Harbour Master may use his discretion regarding usage of dinghy park slots by recognised organisations and temporary lets.
- 14 Any abandoned vessels or vessels left on the dinghy park without identification **WILL BE DISPOSED OF.**
