BOAT SECURITY IN YARMOUTH**

Yarmouth Harbour has in the last few weeks suffered from a spate of crime. Fuel tanks have been emptied or stolen, and boats have had equipment removed. This has occurred in the boatyards and to vessels whilst on their moorings.

It is a reminder to all of us to be more vigilant, especially at this time of year with darker nights and a less busy harbour.

Please if at all possible remove anything of value from your boat. Lock your boat, mark any equipment, and visit your vessel regularly to ensure it remains secure.

If you do suffer a theft please report it to the Police on 0845 045 45 45, and complete an Incident Report form at the Harbour Office. Together with the help of the Police we must try to keep thefts to a minimum in Yarmouth Harbour.
