**Reporting of Oil Pollution in Yarmouth (Isle of
Wight) Harbour or Immediate Approaches**

Date: 06 January 2020

In order that oil pollution may be effectively dealt with, all mariners, recreational craft users, or other persons sighting significant oil pollution in the waters of Yarmouth Harbour or its immediate approaches are invited to report the sighting, giving if possible, the position, extent, description (light film, slick, heavy black crude etc) and direction of drift. Very light patches of oil should not be reported.

Reports should be made as follows:

To HM Coastguard (Call sign "Solent Coastguard" on VHF Ch. 67

Or

By Telephone on 023 9255 2100

Pollution reports will be co-ordinated by Solent Coastguard and the appropriate authorities will put into operation all necessary action to deal with the pollution.
