Yarmouth Harbour

COVID-19 ALL VESSELS 25/03/2020

All non-UK flagged vessels arriving in Yarmouth are requested to pick up an Outer Mooring Buoy. Once berthed, the master of the vessel must then **contact Yarmouth Harbour by telephone on 01983 760321 or on VHF ch68** informing us of your arrival and we will inform you of any special instructions. Once the master of the vessel has made contact and received permission, they can then proceed to a berth as designated to them. See diagram for outer mooring buoys.

The master of the vessel must inform us of your point of origin and any ports visited along the way. The master of the vessel must also **report anyone on board the vessel who has in the last 14 days been to a foreign country - see coronavirus advice for travellers - or if they have been in close contact with anybody showing symptoms or a confirmed case of COVID-19 infection within the 14 days prior to the vessel arriving in Yarmouth.**
