Port Waste Management Plan

Introduction

Yarmouth Harbour (IOW) is a small Trust Port. There is a regular ferry connecting it with Lymington on the mainland but otherwise no large vessels use the harbour. Most of the waste is generated by harbour management operations, small commercial vessels such as fishing boats and visiting recreational craft.

The main commercial operator using the harbour are Wightlink ferries. Waste generated within the ferry operations is deposited in their own facilities at Lymington. Passengers generate litter that is collected in the litter bins and then transferred to the skips for disposal via the waste contractor.

Other than the ferries, commercial craft consist of small fishing vessels, hire/charter boats and summer pleasure boats that are licensed to carry up to 12 passengers. Waste generated is mainly general, which goes into the skip. Waste oil is disposed of in the waste oil tank.

The harbour is used extensively by recreational craft consisting of permanent mooring holders and visitors. Waste generated is mainly general, which can be disposed of in the skip or recycled. A tank is provided for small deposits of waste oil.

As a general policy statement, Yarmouth (IOW) Harbour Commissioners encourage all vessels to segregate their waste and encourage the re-cycling of waste.

Charges for the collection of waste are included in the Harbour dues and mooring fees.

Duties and Responsibilities

The Commissioners have a duty to maintain Yarmouth (IOW) Harbour in a condition fit to be used as a port. The Yarmouth (IOW) Harbour General Directions prohibits the discharge into the Harbour of any dangerous or offensive matter. No articles or goods are to be deposited on Commissioners' property without the prior approval of the Harbour Master. A person who fails to comply with the General Directions or Special Directions shall be guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level four on the standard scale.

Reporting of inadequacies

Incident/Comment reporting forms are available on request at the Harbour office. Reports are reviewed and logged when received.

Records

Invoices and quantity reports from contractors are to be kept onsite for a minimum of 3 years. Record keeping is the responsibility of the maintenance manager.

Consultation

Yarmouth Harbour Commissioners consult with stakeholders through the Yarmouth Harbour Advisory Committee (YHAC) of which 6 meetings are held a year unless additional meetings are required.

Categories of Waste Managed

Subject	Definition	Collection point	Responsible person
<u>Garbage</u>	Also called general waste. This covers items such as paper, plastics, and natural materials such as wood and waste cloth.	Skip 17m ³ . located to the southwest next to the crane area the Harbour Office. General waste bins are available at the dinghy park slipway south of the bridge.	Contracted to: Biffa. Exchange requests made via the Maintenance manager.
<u>Re-cycling</u>	Available facilities for re-cycling are: Glass, aluminium cans and engine batteries.	Three colours of glass can be re-cycled by the Harbour Office: Clear, Green and Brown. Located to the southwest next to the crane area the Harbour Office. Engine batteries can be disposed in the grey container behind the skip.	Contracted to: Biffa Exchange requests made via the Maintenance Supervisor.
<u>Sewage</u>	Human waste from Harbour staff and visiting vessels.	A connection point is provided at the fuel berth for vessel discharge.	Southern Water. Harbour facilities general maintenance by Maintenance manager.
<u>Waste oil</u>	Small volumes of waste oil, lubricants and fuel residues.	There is a small bunded tank (10,000 litre) provided on the quay to the East of the main Harbour Office.	Contracted out to: OSS Group Ltd
<u>Chemicals</u>	Substances produced by chemistry. Usually not natural such as paints and cleaners.	Petroleum based chemicals in liquid form are collected in a container outside the workshop. Other chemicals in limited amounts but in dry form are deposited in the skips.	Contracted to: OSS Group Limited
<u>Refrigerants (CFC)</u> No disposal allowed within Harbour limits.	Usually the working fluids in refrigerators or freezers.	Special facilities are provided at the Council Public collection point in Newport (weekdays) and Freshwater (weekends)	Isle of Wight Council.
<u>Absorbents 15 15 02</u> Usually used by Harbour Operatives.	In the case of an oil spill or other pollutant, absorbent material can be used to contain the spill.	Contaminated absorbent or combustible materials are stored in metal containers at the fuel berth and to the east of the harbour office.	Contracted to: OSS Group Ltd
<u>Flares</u>	Out of date emergency pyrotechnics.	No facility for collection provided by the harbour. Local chandlery offers a limited service.	Harwood's Yacht Chandlery
<u>Litter</u>	General light waste, paper, tins and light plastics.	Collected in litterbins located in public areas.	Harbour Staff to transfer to skip
